

THE TREES & SHRUBS OF KLEHM 2008

GOLDFINCH MAGNOLIA (*Magnolia* x 'Goldfinch') A hybrid of the Cucumbertree Magnolia (which is scattered throughout the grounds of Klehm), 'Goldfinch' has light yellow flowers on a tall upright form, and is one of the hardiest yellow-flowering magnolias. Given room to grow, it may reach 50' high. ['Ellen', a similar variety, is 110' east of the big boulder and 20' north of the Wildflower Trail]

MERRILL MAGNOLIA (*Magnolia* x *loebneri* 'Merrill') An early-flowering hybrid magnolia with fragrant white tepals covering the tree, and foliage that emerges bronzy green, maturing to dark green, and becoming yellow-bronze in fall. 25' high and 30' wide. [East Loop at #24]

MT AIRY FOTHERGILLA (*Fothergilla major* 'Mt. Airy') Also known as the Bottlebrush Plant (for the 1 ½ - 2" long fragrant creamy white spring flowers resembling bottlebrushes) and Jacob's Coat Plant (for the stunning many-hued fall foliage), 'Mt. Airy' has dark blue-green foliage during the summer. 5 to 6' high and slightly less in spread. [Dwarf varieties in front of the Visitor's Center & CLARCOR]

JUDD VIBURNUM (*Viburnum* x *juddii*) Every bit as fragrant as the Koreanspice Viburnum (which is one of its parents), the hybrid Judd Viburnum is an adaptable and floriferous shrub. It has a mature height of 6' or so, and a full and rounded growth habit. [East Loop, by the rock at the bridge entrance to the Children's Garden]

KENTUCKY COFFEE TREE (*Gymnocladus dioica*) Unique tree with bipinnately compound leaves. Suitable for parks and large areas. 60'-75' in height and 40'-50' spread. Tolerant of adverse conditions, such as salt, poor soil, pollution and drought. Seed pods, leaflets, and rachises can be messy. There are many specimens around Klehm's parking lot and throughout the grounds.

HACKBERRY (*Celtis occidentalis*) Large tree 40'-60' in height and a nearly equal spread. Can grow to 100'. There is a large specimen just west of the koi pond at the Children's Garden entrance and many nice specimens around the Visitor's Center. The Hackberry is very tough and adaptable.
